Minden Pool Rules:

- Absolutely NO running.
- No dunking.
- No play objects in the deep water.
- No pushing.
- Stay off ropes.
- One bounce on the boards.
- No shoulder riding.
- No backing up on the boards.
- Only two people on the boards at one time.
- Eligibility for the deep requires completing the water competency sequence for a lifeguard on duty. Lifeguard must be in the water for all tests
- Appropriate swim attire must be worn at all times.
- No profanity or abusive language will be tolerated.
- Ten-minute rest breaks will occur every hour. Patrons should use this time to sit and rest away from the edge of the pool. If you are 18 years of age or older, you may remain swimming.
- Children under 8 years must be supervised by an adult or caregiver at all times. The caregiver must be at least 14 years of age.
- Children 4 years old and under, as well as all non-swimmers, must be within arm's reach of a supervising adult or caregiver at all times. The caregiver must be at least 14 years of age. Lifejackets/floaties of any kind indicate the child is a non-swimmer.
- Lifeguards reserve the right to ask anyone to leave if improper conduct is exhibited.
- Swimmers will not be permitted into the pool if muddy.

2019 SUMMER POOL PASS

State of Nebraska Pool Regulations:

- No person is permitted to use the pool without first having taken a warm water shower, using soap.
- No person having an obvious communicable disease, skin eruption, cut, sore or lesion, eye, ear, nose, or throat infection is permitted to use any public swimming pool.
- Spitting or spouting water, blowing nose, or any other similar activities in the swimming pool is strictly prohibited.
- No running, boisterous or rough play, except supervised water sports, is permitted in the pool, or on the runways, diving boards, floats, platforms, or dressing rooms.
- Maximum patron load is 100 persons.

Disciplinary Actions

- Lifeguards will use their whistle, voice, or hand gestures to get Patron's attention or give warning.
- Lifeguards will explain what rule was broken and consequences if the rule is broken again.
- If the rule is broken a second time the Patron will be asked to sit out.
- Pool Supervisor or Pool Manager may be contacted if problems continue to rise.

Suspension

- Guards are allowed to ask patrons to leave at their discretion.
- Patrons could be suspended for the following reasons:
 - Whenever safety is a concern to others
 - Fighting on City property
 - Already given several warnings
 - Stealing will result in a suspension for the rest of the season
 - Disrespectful actions towards staff or other patrons

Severe Weather Procedures

- Management will try to notify the public as soon as possible for closings, postponements, and cancellations of scheduled events.
- Anytime thunder/lightening are detected, the pool and associated decks will be cleared. Weather related closings are at management's discretion.
- No swimming is allowed during inclement weather conditions.
- The Pool Tornado Shelter is the two bathrooms, signs are posted in both.
