RESOLUTION NO. 1681

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was signed in to law on October 30, 2000, placing new emphasis on state and local mitigation planning for natural hazards and requiring communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS, a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared by the Tri-Basin Natural Resources District, with assistance from JEO Consulting Group, Inc. of Lincoln, NE, which includes City of Minden.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the mitigation plan was to lessen the effects of disasters by increasing the disaster resistance of the Natural Resources District and participating jurisdictions located within the planning boundary by identifying the hazards that affect City of Minden and prioritize mitigation strategies to reduce potential loss of life and property damage from those hazards, and

WHEREAS, FEMA regulations require documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of City of Minden in the form of a resolution and further requesting approval of the plan at the Federal Level; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Minden, Nebraska, the City of Minden does herewith adopt the Tri-Basin Natural Resources District Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update in its entirety.

Councilmember Carlson moved for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution. Councilmember Sumstine seconded the motion.

On roll call the following voted Aye: Evans, Sumstine, and Carlson. Absent: Jones.

The passage of said Resolution having been consented to by a majority of the members of the City Council, the Mayor declared the Resolution passed and adopted, this 4th day of June, 2018.
