



**RESOLUTION #1595**  
**Electrical Rate Adjustment**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City Of Minden realize the electrical rates of the City Of Minden, Nebraska must be adjusted from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City Of Minden realize it is in the best interest of the City Of Minden and its citizens to maintain the municipal electrical system in a solvent position; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City Of Minden realize the costs associated with the operation of the municipal electrical system are ever increasing; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City Of Minden have knowledge of the increase in the cost of wholesale power provided by NPPD; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City Of Minden have reviewed the audits, current revenues, solvency of the electrical department, the recommendations of the City Administrator, and has found that the following rates are just and equitable, and should be applied to all billings made by the Electrical Department of the City of Minden on or after March 1, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINDEN, NEBRASKA

Section 1. Effective on the billing of March 1, 2013 to be made to users of electricity supplied by the City of Minden Electrical Department of the City of Minden, Nebraska, the rates charged by the City Electrical Department shall be as follows:
