Bill Paying:

Utility bills are due on the 10th of the month. If the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or City observed holiday, the due date becomes the next business day. If not paid on or before the due date, the bill will incur a penalty charge of 10%. If an account is delinquent, service will be disconnected after 10:00 am on the last Tuesday of the month.

Disconnect Fees:

If you have been disconnected for non-payment, the following are the applicable fees:

- \$100.00 for Disconnection
- \$100.00 for Reconnection outside regular business hours (in addition to the Disconnect Fee)

Reminders

Fireworks Rules:

- Beginning Saturday, June 29th, lighting of fireworks is permitted from 8am to 10pm. The time is extended to midnight on July 3rd and 4th.

Fireworks Display:

- On July 2nd the City and Chamber of Commerce will hold its annual fireworks show at the Kearney County Fairgrounds at 10pm.

Building Permits:

- The City would like to remind residents that building permits need to be approved before projects are started. Please allow a minimum of 2 weeks for permit processing before starting. For a complete list of projects that require building permits, please see the building permit application at City Hall (325 N Colorado) or on the City website.

Hydrant Flushing:

- The City of Minden has begun its annual flushing of fire hydrants. This process does stir up sediment and may cause temporary discoloration of your water. Running your faucets will reduce the discoloration while the sediment moves through the water system.

Mosquito Prevention:

- You can help keep the mosquito population down by removing any mosquito habitats. Some ways to help eliminate habitats are as follows: eliminating standing water in gutters, tires, buckets, plastic covers and toys; empty and change water in bird baths, fountains, wading pools, rain barrels and potted plant trays at least once a week.



Grass Height Reminder:

Owners & occupants of any property within City limits are required to keep their lots and alleys free of any weeds, grasses or unsightly vegetation in excess of 9 inches of growth. If in violation of this ordinance, the City may take action to remedy at the expense of the owner/occupant.

WATER RESTRICTIONS

*Currently, the City is NOT restricting water.
The Water Conservation Stages are listed below.*

Stage 1: Water Watch

- Reduce weekly water consumption by 7%

Stage 2: Water Warning

- Reduce weekly water consumption by 15%
- Staggered Lawn Watering
 - Even Number homes water on Even Days
 - Odd Number homes water on Odd Days
 - Lawn Watering is restricted between 11am & 7pm

Stage 3: Water Emergency

- Reduce weekly water consumption by 25%
- Outdoor Watering Prohibited


