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RESOLUTION NO. 1800 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AIRPORT AUTHORITY'S LEVY REQUEST

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Minden is in receipt of the City of Minden Airport Authority Resolution No. 24-1, and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the City of Minden has been considering the budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, and

WHEREAS, Nebraska Statute 77-3443 (3) requires all political subdivisions subject to city/village levy authority to submit a preliminary request for levy allocation to the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council shall consider the preliminary request for levy request in full or in part, and as a part of the budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council realize the City of Minden Airport Authority is requesting \$57,000, a proposed levy that is the same as the levy requested for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council authorized a levy in the amount of \$57,000 for the final levy amount for Fiscal Year 2024-2025.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINDEN:

1. As required by Nebraska Statute 77-3443 (4), the final allocation of levy authority for the Minden Airport Authority for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 shall be \$57,000.
2. As required by Nebraska Statute 77-3443 (4), a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Chairperson of the City of Minden Airport Authority after its passage according to law.

Council member Yant moved for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution. Council member J. Kring seconded the motion.

On roll call the following voted Aye: J. Kring, Yant, and Schneider. Absent and not voting: Sumstine.

The passage of said Resolution having been consented to by a majority of the members of the City Council, the Mayor declared the Resolution passed and adopted, this 29th day of July, 2024.
