## Bill Paying:

Utility bills are due on the 10th of the month. If the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or City observed holiday, the due date becomes the next business day. If not paid on or before the due date, the bill will incur a penalty charge of 10%. If an account is delinquent, service will be disconnected after 10:00 am on the last Tuesday of the month.

## Disconnect Fees:

If you have been disconnected for non-payment, the following are the applicable fees:

- \$100.00 for Disconnection
- \$100.00 for Reconnection outside regular business hours (in addition to the Disconnect Fee)

## Online Utility Payments:

- Online payments can be made on our City Website for Utility Bills ONLY.

- Card payments will have an additional fee added, shown on summary page, Bank payments do not have a fee.

## Snow Emergency

A snow emergency is declared as conditions warrant & parking is prohibited on all Emergency Snow Routes. Vehicles in violation may be towed. Visit the City's website to see an Emergency Snow Routes Map or sign up to receive email or text notification of an emergency via the "How Do I..." menu at [mindennebraska.org](http://mindennebraska.org).

Snow & ice are to be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after snowfall ends & cannot be scooped on streets or alleys except for in the C-1 business district.

A parking prohibition may be put into effect for specific areas or all residential streets by declaring parking to be prohibited on one side of the street. Designation of either odd or even addressed numbered sides will be made, & the date & time this will take affect will be announced when determined.



## Snow Removal Reminders

- Please clear snow that is on and around trash cans, dumpsters and cages. The truck may not be able to pick it up if not.



- Please clear snow from fire hydrants so that emergency personnel can easily find them if needed.
