Bill Paying:

Utility bills are due on the 10th of the month. If the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or City observed holiday, the due date becomes the next business day. If not paid on or before the due date, the bill will incur a penalty charge of 10%. If an account is delinquent, service will be disconnected after 10:00 am on the last Tuesday of the month.

Disconnect Fees:

If you have been disconnected for non-payment, the following are the applicable fees:

- \$100.00 for Disconnection
- \$100.00 for Reconnection outside regular business hours (in addition to the Disconnect Fee)

Online Utility Payments:

- Online payments can be made on our City Website for Utility Bills ONLY.

- Card payments will have an additional fee added, shown on summary page, Bank payments do not have a fee.

Cross Connection Survey:

- The State of Nebraska Dept. of Health requires a cross connection survey to be completed by ALL residential and commercial sites at least once every 5 yrs. This survey is to determine if cross connections exist that would allow impure water, gas, or liquid to gain entrance to the plumbing system to contaminate or pollute a safe water supply system in the event of a system backflow.

Meter Reminders:

- The City would like to remind residents that missing or damaged meters and/or radios are billable to the homeowner.
- While re-siding or painting please do **NOT** paint over these, or if they are removed please put back. If they are in your way contact City Hall to schedule the removal and replacement for you.

Mosquito Prevention:

- You can help keep the mosquito population down by removing any mosquito habitats. Some ways to help eliminate habitats are as follows: eliminating standing water in gutters, tires, buckets, plastic covers and toys; empty and change water in bird baths, fountains, wading pools, rain barrels and potted plant trays at least once a week.

Grass Height:

- Owners and occupants of any property within the City limits are required to keep their lots and alleys free of any weeds, grasses or unsightly vegetation in excess of 9 inches of growth.
- If in violation the City may take action to remedy at the expense of the owner/occupant.

New Billing Email:

- The email that you receive your monthly utility bills from has changing. In June, your utility bills started coming from: utilities@MindenNebraskaBilling.org
- Please check your email inbox around the 25th of the month, if you do not see it, search your spam and mark it as safe.

Water Discoloration:

- The City has been seeing an increased amount of iron and manganese in our water system that has resulted in brown water. We are currently working with various engineers and experts to determine how we can better treat our water to limit the discoloration in our system. We will continue to flush our system when necessary. Please contact City Hall when you notice a discoloration of your water so we can address it.

Budget Billing:

- The City of Minden has re-evaluated the Utility Billing Budget amounts. The new budget amounts will be reflected on this Utility Bill due in August through July 2026. If you have questions about your new budget amount or would like to sign up, please contact City Hall.
- To enroll or to remain on budget billing residents will need to have 12 months of no late payments (no payments after the 10th of each month)

Building Permits:

- The City would like to remind residents that building permits need to be approved before any projects are started. Please allow a minimum of 2 weeks for permit processing before starting. For a complete list of projects that require building permits, please review the building permit application at City Hall (325 N Colorado) or on the City website.
