Bill Paying:

Utility bills are due on the 10th of the month. If the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or City observed holiday, the due date becomes the next business day. If not paid on or before the due date, the bill will incur a penalty charge of 10%. If an account is delinquent, service will be disconnected after 10:00 am on the last Tuesday of the month.

Disconnect Fees:

If you have been disconnected for non-payment, the following are the applicable fees:

- \$100.00 for Disconnection
- \$100.00 for Reconnection outside regular business hours (in addition to the Disconnect Fee)

Online Utility Payments:

- Online payments can be made on our City Website for Utility Bills ONLY.
- Please visit mindennebraska.org and click "Utility Payments" for instructions or by scanning the QR Code.
- Card payments will have an additional fee added, shown on summary page, Bank payments do not have a fee.

The City of Minden is a supporter of Fair Housing and supports the Title VIII of Civil Right Act of 1968 which prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of dwellings based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability, or familial status. Title VIII also sets forth the enforcement mechanisms enabling U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development attorneys to bring action before administrative law judges on behalf of victims of housing discrimination; and allowing the Department of Justice to bring suit on behalf of victims in Federal district courts. Furthermore, the City supports the elimination of unlawful discriminatory practices within its jurisdictional boundaries.

Did you know?

- The City is able to accept card payments through the office and online, but did you know that you can schedule the payments yourself without the service fee?
- You create your own account with Doxo, and can have your payment withdrawn from your bank account without that extra fee!

Yard Waste:

- Yard waste (tree branches, grass clippings, weeds) will NOT be accepted in your trash cans. If yard waste is in your can, it will not be picked up. Please take all yard waste to the City Landfill located on Hwy 6/34 and 35 Road.
- ONLY trees, tree branches, grass clippings and leaves are allowed at the City Landfill. No processed wood!

Back to School:

- As students head back to class, let's all do our part to keep them safe:
 - Slow down in school zones and neighborhoods.
 - Stop for school buses when lights are flashing.
 - Watch for children at crosswalks, especially during morning and afternoon hours.
 - Avoid distractions while driving – phones can wait.
- Remind students to use crosswalks, obey crossing guards, and make eye contact with drivers before crossing.

Building Permits:

- The City would like to remind residents that building permits need to be approved before any projects are started. Please allow a minimum of 2 weeks for permit processing before starting.
