### Bill Paying:

Utility bills are due on the 10th of the month. If the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or City observed holiday, the due date becomes the next business day. If not paid on or before the due date, the bill will incur a penalty charge of 10%. If an account is delinquent, service will be disconnected after 10:00 am on the last Tuesday of the month.

### Disconnect Fees:

If you have been disconnected for non-payment, the following are the applicable fees:

- \$100.00 for Disconnection
- \$100.00 for Reconnection outside regular business hours (in addition to the Disconnect Fee)

- Online payments can be made on our City Website for Utility Bills ONLY.

- Card payments will have an additional fee added, shown on summary page, Bank payments do not have a fee.

### Sanitation Rates:

- On December 15, 2025, the City Council approved an increase in sanitation rates that are to take effect February 1st.
- The changes include:
  - Residential increased to \$20 per totter
  - Commercial increased to \$23 per totter

### Did you know?

- On February 12, 1883 Minden was organized as a village with a population of 200 people.
- In March of 1888 it was changed from a village to an incorporated second-class city.
- Minden is named after Minden, Germany, the home town of Frederick Bredemier.
  - Frederick and his brother August made their homestead west of the current Minden, NE.
  - They were the first settlers in Hayes Township, Kearney County in 1874.


